### VENUE

### SPEAKERS PRE-VIEW ROOM

There will be a Speakers' Pre-View Room situated in Ombu B Room (2<sup>nd</sup> floor). Speakers can check in, drop off and finalize their PowerPoint® presentations.

To avoid delays caused by switching computers at the platform booting-up computers and potential compatibility problems, the Congress will provide speakers with the standard A/V system for computer projection. To ensure smooth transition between speakers and appropriate audiovisual technical support, it is requested that speakers do not plan on connecting their laptop to the LCD projector, nor even bring their own LCDs.



**Every speaker has to go to the Pre-View room beforehand to bring his PowerPoint® presentation, at least three hours before the beginning of the session.** Speakers making their presentation in the early morning sessions should ensure that they have checked-in during the previous day.

## **AUDIOVISUAL GUIDELINES**

---

Speakers must bring their presentations to the **Speakers Pre-View Room**, located on the **Second Floor (Ombu B Room)**, at least 3 hours prior to their presentations. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TIME PERIOD IS FOR TRIALLING AND NOT EDITING.

Please find below some suggestions to enhance your presentation:

1. Use CD ROM or USB, and bring at least 2 copies of your presentation should there be technical problems or loss of material.
2. Presentations must be done in **PowerPoint**® format: Office 2000, 2003, 2007 or Office XP.
3. Please use standard fonts. Use no more than 2 fonts on a slide. Avoid using ALL CAPS and italics. Confirm a font size of AT LEAST 24 points for body text and 36-40 points for headings. Light coloured text on a dark background works well; avoid using red and green as well as overcrowding and coloured text that “clashes”. Use simple graphics. Images to be inserted in slides should be resized to approximately 800 x 600 pixels and saved as jpeg or tiff files.
4. If the CD has been loaded in a “Macintosh”, then it should be formatted to PC. This step can be omitted if the speaker brings his own “Macintosh”, which will be connected directly to the multimedia projector. If you will be using a Macintosh laptop computer, you must also provide the video adapter cable to appropriately connect your computer as these will not be available on-site.
5. In case the presentation has videos, it is highly advisable to save files using Windows Media (.avi, .wmv), MPEG (.mpg, .mpeg, .mpe, .mpa, .m1v, .mp2, .mpv2, .mp2v), in order to ensure the success of the presentation. In case mpeg format is chosen and there is a sound track, it should be MPEG Layer II. We cannot guarantee that DIVX, DVD, Real Player, VCD and Quick Time videos are played safely on PowerPoint, since originally this software does not support these formats.

Only the sessions indicated with this symbol  will be provided with simultaneous translation *English-Spanish* and *Spanish-English*.

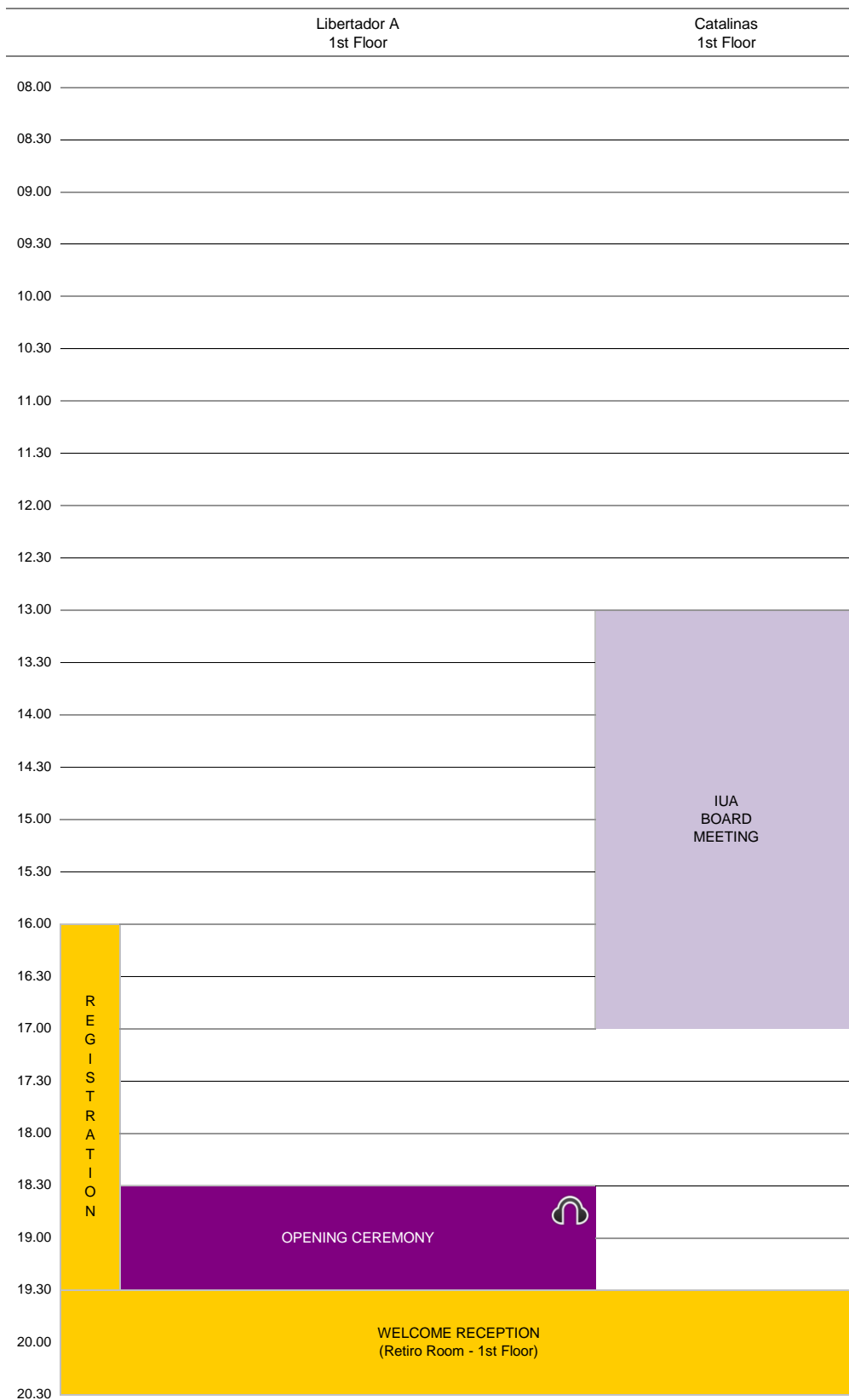
